



**Ghada El-Hajj Fuleihan, MD,MPH.**

Dr El-Hajj Fuleihan is Professor of Medicine, Associate Dean of Clinical Research, and Director of the Calcium Metabolism and Osteoporosis Program, at the American University of Beirut.

Dr El-Hajj Fuleihan obtained her MD degree from the American University of Beirut and completed her residency and fellowship at the New England Deaconess and Brigham and Women's Hospitals, Harvard Medical School, Boston. She also received a master in Public Health from the Harvard School of Public Health.

Dr. El-Hajj Fuleihan's major research interests revolve around osteoporosis and metabolic bone disorders, hypovitaminosis D, calcium-sensing, and women's health issues. She has published on her topics of interest in over 100 publications, including peer reviewed original investigations, Editorials in the New England of Medicine and Journal of Clinical Endocrinology and Metabolism, reviews, chapters in reference textbooks and in the CD Rom UpToDate. Dr El-Hajj Fuleihan was elected to the Board of Directors of the International Bone and Mineral Society for a three year term in 2008, serves on the Ethics Advisory Committee of the American Society of Bone and Mineral Research, and on the Committee of Scientific Advisors of the International Osteoporosis Foundation. She is also on the International Relations Committee of the International Society of Clinical Densitometry, and is a full faculty member for its certification courses. Dr El-Hajj Fuleihan served on the editorial board of the Journal of Clinical Endocrinology and Metabolism, and is currently on the editorial board for the Journal of Bone and Mineral Research, and the Journal of Clinical Densitometry.
